YOUR SHORES ELECTION BALLOT IS VERY IMPORTANT!!!

It is that time of year again when Shores owners must elect their Board Members and District Delegate for the coming year. A certain percentage of votes must be collected in order for our election to meet legal requirements and ballots must be returned in a very specific manner. Our preference is for Street Reps to hand collect as many votes as possible so we are assured we have the required number. You may give your completed ballot to your street rep or leave it in their electrical box, send it in to StoneKastle, or leave it at the front desk at the Club House.

COMPLETING YOUR BALLOT

Once you have determined what your vote will be, complete your ballot and seal it within the white envelope. Put your white envelope inside the green one and seal it. Write your name on the outside of the green envelope, print your last name and list your street. Finally, make sure your street rep knows how your vote is being submitted - or simply give it to your street rep. Street Representative names and numbers are listed on the back page of this newsletter.

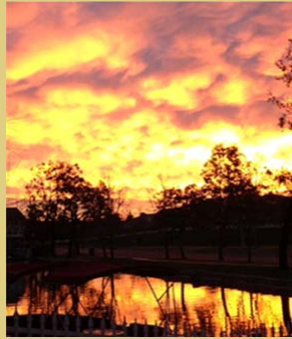
