

EXCITING NEWS FOR OUR LAKE

For many years we have been missing one key element that every lake needs, and that is plant material. We tried lilies many years ago but those did not work for many reasons. We do have algae in our lake that is beneficial although we also have a nasty algae called Prymnesium Parvum (Golden Algae) that we have been battling for three and a half years .

Our Lake Management Committee and staff have been studying, and researching this algae, and like every other body of water across the nation that has this particular algae there is no known cure. The Golden Algae in our lake does not have a strong competitor, and this we know through water sampling and algae indentification. We are striving to maintain an aesthetic, chemical free waterscape with a biodiversity of healthy aquatic. The can be reached by using floating islands that are moored and controlled by us. What we cannot do is allow plant material to run rampant due to the fact that our lake is used for boating. The roots from the plants will consume an enormous amount of nutrients from the lake while creating an aquatic ecology that will be detrimental to the Golden Algae. These islands may also act as a safe haven for the fish in the event of the Golden Algae releasing it's toxins.

We have been working on a project with Floating Islands West for over



6 months and this past week we have installed our first 25x5 foot floating island. We have 2 more that will be adjacent to the current island in front of the family pool. One more will be installed which will be 50x5 feet containing the same aquatic plants, and will be placed in front of the clubhouse. We will be planting many more flowering plants within the same islands once they are available. The plant material chosen along with high efficiency aeration (hydraulic flushing) is key to the success. We have already installed 3 high efficiency diffusers in this area that are moving an enormous *(Continued on page 2)*

amount of water. This process will also disperse and remove silt from the bottom of the lake which if not eventually removed could result in possible dredging of the lake to remove sediment.

The islands will have a netting structure above which are only there to keep the coots from eating the plant material. Once the plants are established, the structure will be removed creating a much more aesthetically pleasing island. Again, there will be more flowering plants arriving in the next month or so. We have also installed small solar lights on the corners of the islands for better visibility at night.

The islands are structurally sound, although we cannot allow people mooring their boats to them. We ask that when boating, homeowners do not travel between the structure (Clubhouse and pool) and the islands. We know this is a change to our normal view of the lake but hope that all understand that this is a very positive move in reaching an equally balanced ecosystem.
