ROOF LEAKS!!

Although we all love to see the rain in Southern California, it has definitely created a lot of unforeseen challenges in the HOA industry.

Fairmont Hill Community Association performs its due diligence annually by having roof maintenance performed in the community. Roof maintenance consists of looking for and replacing cracked tiles, removing roof debris and the re-sealing of joints and vent pipes. Unfortunately there is not a way to know if a roof will leak unless a water test is performed.

Fairmont Hill roofs and every roof in California has had continuous "water tests" in the last several months. Roofing contractors throughout the state have been inundated with leak reports.

Due to the number of leaks reported in Fairmont Hill and the cost of repairs, management was instructed to obtain additional proposals for the Board to review. We are pleased to advise the membership the Board approved the proposals presented by Antis Roofing to perform all the roof repairs in the community. Work is scheduled to start in four to six weeks as this is the soonest they can get the material and the crews on site.
