VIRGINIA'S POOL SIDE CHAT

Board Meetings: The Board meets on the fourth Tuesday of the month. The next board meeting is May 23rd, Executive Session 7:00 PM, Regular Session 7:30 PM, Glenwood Clubhouse.

Fiber Optic Cable: SiFi Network representative provided that Glenwood is scheduled for a final construction walkout on May 31st. Two board members plan on being present for this.

Podocarpus Trees Along Drive: Treeco has trimmed the Podocarpus trees along the Drive.

<u>Flat Roofs Over Garages</u>: The proposal for replacement of the flat roofs is still pending from Antis. Further information will be provided in future newsletter(s).

Street Light Pole: The streetlight pole has been replaced by Tyler Lighting. To protect the new pole from future damage the board approved the installation of two bumper guards.

<u>Glenwood Sign</u>: The letter "d" on the Glenwood sign has been replaced. The Board is continuing to monitor the overall appearance of the sign and will take further action if needed.

Pool Deck Tables: The acrylic pool deck table tops have been replaced with aluminum tops. The replacement from acrylic to aluminum is cost effective for the community since several of the acrylic tabletops have been broken in the past.

Pool Mastic and Deck Coating: The Board approved a proposal to make deck repairs which include replacing mastic, filling cracks with urethane sealant, and applying color sealer to match existing deck and coping color.

<u>Clubhouse and Common Area Repairs</u>: Various common area repairs have been made which include clubhouse repairs such as the hole in the dry wall, fixing the door, cleaning the windows, replacement of sidewalk ramp, and two stair handrails in common area.

Workout Room: The Board is looking into acquiring three new items of workout equipment for the clubhouse. The three equipment items are: treadmill, elliptical machine, and a recumbent bike.

Glenwood's Insurance Policies: At the March board meeting, the board approved renewal of the Association's property and general liability insurance policies with State Farm for a total annual premium of \$26,325. The property insurance has a \$10,000 deductible per occurrence.

At the April board meeting the Board plans to discuss the renewal of the Association's earthquake policy.

Importance of Homeowner Unit Policies: The Association's property insurance policy covers only the structure, and if you own your home, you should consider obtaining a "Unit Owners Policy" covering replacement of your property for such things as personal property, wall and floor coverings, home improvements/upgrades, additional expenses while you are out of your home after a loss, personal liability, and the Association's master policy deductible. If you own and use your property as a rental, it is important to have a policy designed for owners of rental property.

In addition, obtaining an individual unit policy for earthquake and flood would assist you in paying large assessments for high deductible Association policies in the event of a catastrophic loss.

Vote by Acclamation: Early notices were mailed in April 2023 notifying homeowners of this year's candidate nomination deadline and of the ability for new directors to be seated by acclamation if all conditions are met. The deadline for submitting candidate nominations is June 30, 2023. Candidate nomination forms will be mailed out to homeowners in May. If you have any questions, please contact Nancy Blasco.
